Course Description

Overview

Students will learn how to set-up a WordPress website and develop the site to include a menu system with navigation bars, widgets for posts and comments, theme, calendar, and interactive forms. The class will be lecture style with some hands –on. If the student has established a WordPress site the student may use their site for the lessons. Some practice on a WordPress site is offered.
