The FashionArt Designs Process

“Patience is a virtue that carries a lot of wait.” - Anonymous

Since each shirt is hand decorated and the only machine I use is an iron, the process takes a week or more to make your custom FashionArt Designs shirt. While I have an inventory of Halloween, PRIDE, Music, and Christmas shirts, the inventory is not extensive. Please have patience as your shirt may take a couple of weeks and know that the shirt is original, like you. Here’s the FashionArt Design tailored process:

Day 1: I wash the shirt to remove sizing and chemicals, so the paint will bond to the fabric. I hang the shirt to dry.

Day 2: I iron the shirt, prep the front of the shirt, paint the front collar, sleeve hems, adorn the right sleeve, and paint the front of the shirt. Finally, I sign, date, and number the shirt at the bottom hem.

Day 3: On day three, I iron the painted areas of the shirt for at least 90 seconds to heat seal the front of the shirt ensuring a secure bonding of the paint to the fabric. If you follow the care instructions, this is why the shirts never fade. After the heat sealing, I paint the back collar and back sleeve hems for Regular shirts. For The Works shirts on Day 3, I add painting to the left sleeve and back of the shirt then the next day, I heat seal the back of the shirt.

I wait 72 hours for the paint to cure and then the shirt is ready for mailing or adding to the inventory. Some shirts require a second coat of paint, have different types of paints, and require longer drying times, so the process can extend to five or more days.

A Special Shirt for a Special Person deserves Special Care

Instructions for a long-lasting, non-fading wearable work of art:

- ✓ Wash inside out, cold water, and gentle cycle,
- ✓ Hang to dry and never put in a dryer,
- ✓ Avoid folding and hang your work of art for storing,
- ✓ **Lightly** iron the painted areas of the shirt inside out,
- ✓ Enjoy your custom shirt for years.

Type of Shirts

T-shirts are the most popular, so I offer crew neck and V-neck shirts plus short or long sleeves shirts. Next, in popularity are crew neck, long sleeves sweatshirts. I offer golf/sports, tuxedo, and dress shirt options, too. My main manufacturers are Gildan for crew neck t-shirts and sweatshirts, and Port for women’s V-neck shirts.

Feel the Difference - Using puffy, slick, and fabric paints changes the feel of the shirt with the texture of the various paints adding a special touch to the shirts. Unlike other shirts, you can feel the difference in a FashionArt Designs shirt. **Since the puffy paint is colorful plastic glue, it will stick to other vinyl, plastic items. Not worry, separate the shirt from the object and all is well.**

Halloween

Be the hit of the **Halloween** season with a special **Halloween** shirt just for you.



My most popular shirt is the Halloween glow-in-the-dark black t-shirt, short and long sleeves, or a sweatshirt. I offer orange shirts with black painting, too, but no glow-in-the-dark.

There is only one way to celebrate the Halloween season and that is to go all out, so I offer this shirt as a FashionArt Designs The Works Shirt with the collar, the sleeves, the sleeve hems, the front, and the back decorated with puffy glow-in-the-dark fabric paint. Pumpkins, spider webs, spiders,



ghosts, bats, snakes, witches, BOO, and other Halloween treats adorn the shirt.



I sign, date, and number every shirt plus include your name, if you like. Your shirt is unique and created just for you, no duplicates. Notice this shirt is from 1993 and the photo taken 30 years later in

2023.

I offer the black short sleeves t-shirt as a crew neck or a V-neck. Sizes are small, medium, large, extra large (XL), XXL, and XXXL. The long sleeves and sweatshirts are crew necks. Here are the prices.

- ✓ Black crew short sleeves shirts are \$40.00.
- ✓ Black women's V-neck short sleeves shirts are \$45.00.
- ✓ Black long sleeves shirts are \$50.
- ✓ Black sweatshirts are \$55.

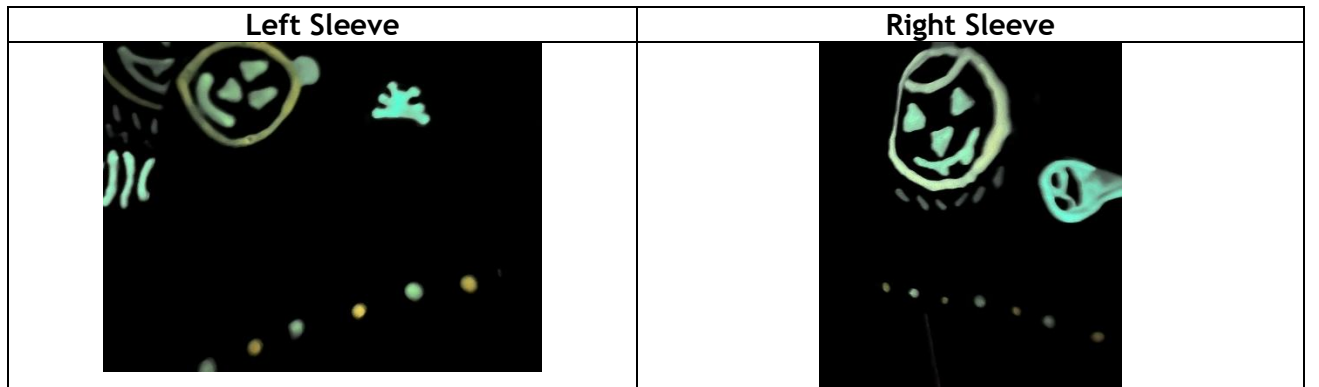
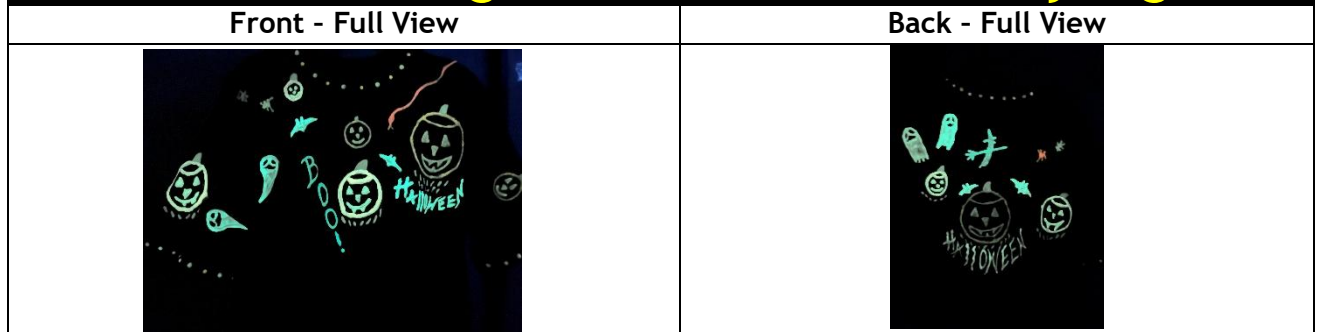

The Traditional Holiday Regular FashionArt Designs shirt has the collar and sleeve hems with holly trim, a Christmas Tree with decorations and presents on the front, holly/tree trim on the right sleeve, green, red, gold, and silver candles on the left sleeve, and the lettering Seasons Greetings in gold glitter. The Works shirt includes the Regular shirt artwork plus has Happy Holidays in green and red paint on the back and holly/tree trim on the back hem of the shirt.

The Works - Regular artwork plus Happy Holidays on the back and artwork on the shirt's back hem.



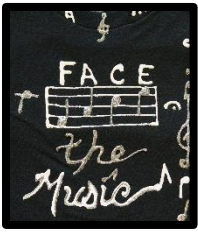
Donning my Gay Apparel: The **PRIDE!** Christmas shirt

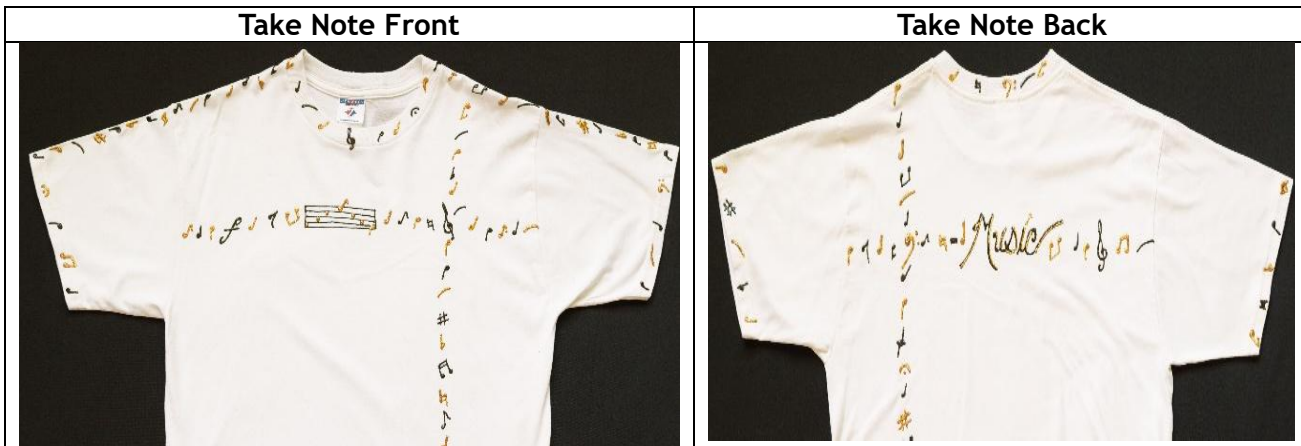
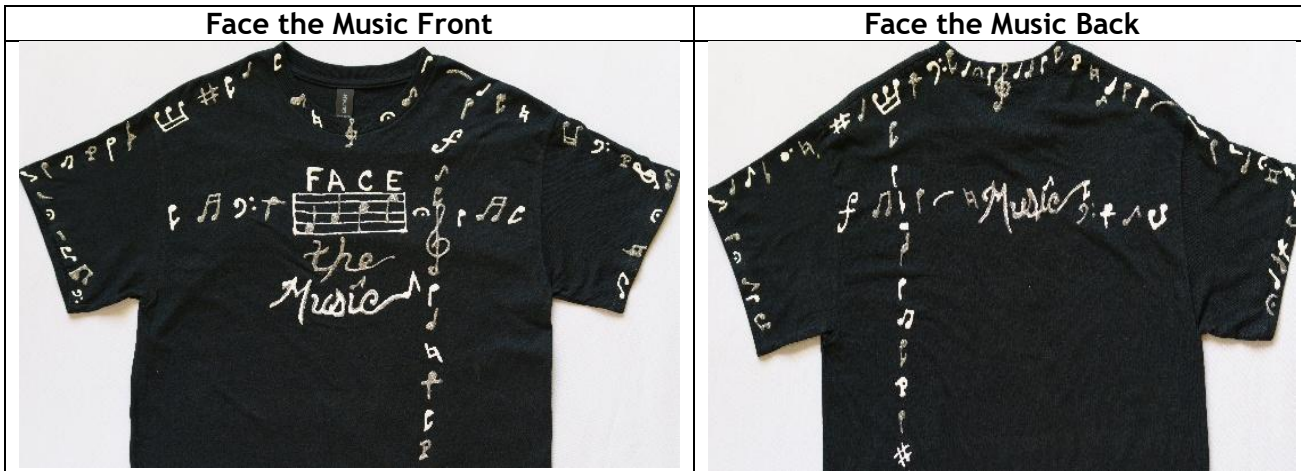

Take Note: Music



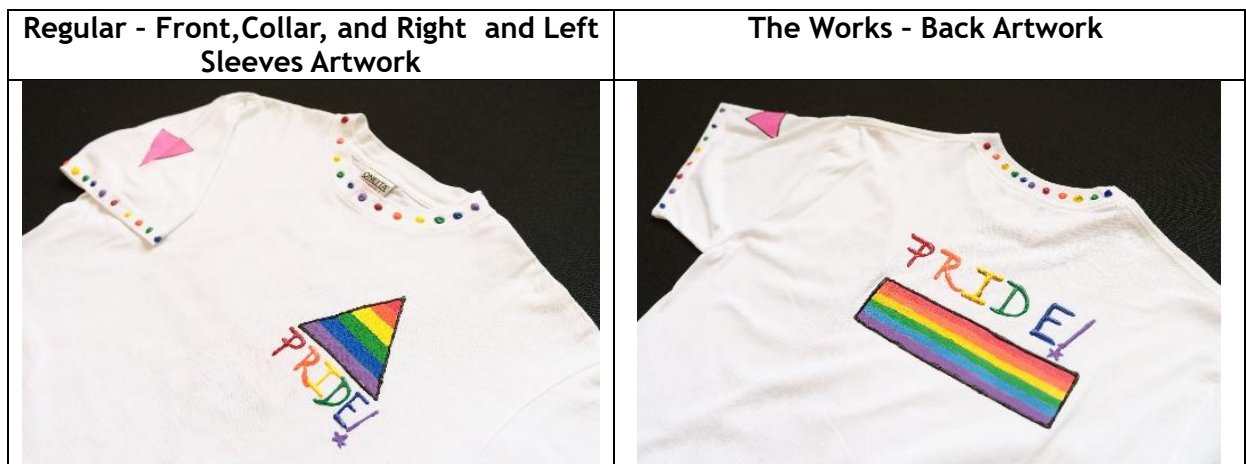
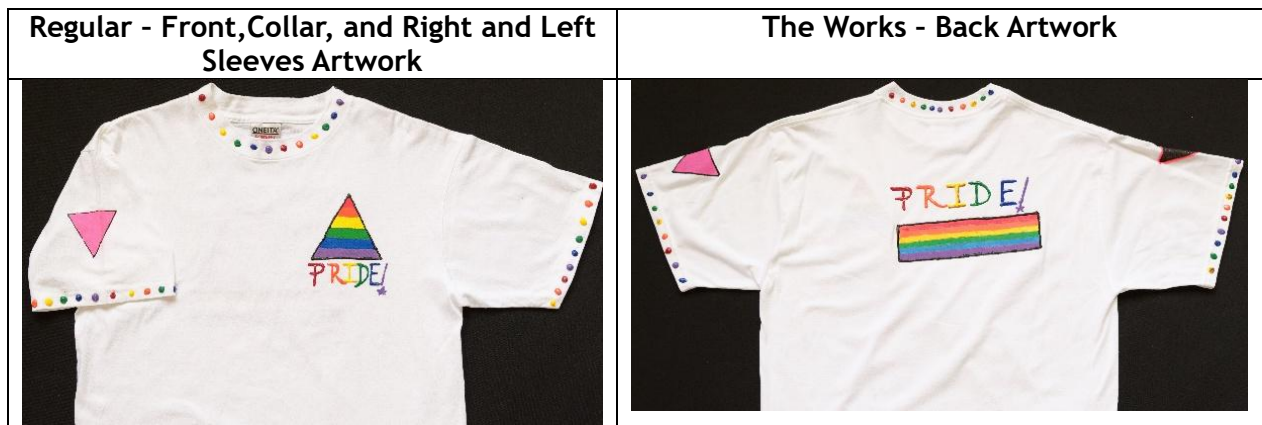

Celebrate your PRIDE! with a custom rainbow PRIDE! shirt to show your true colors! While this shirt celebrates PRIDE! for today's LGBT community, the shirt honors our gay and lesbian history. The pink triangle on one sleeve is in remembrance of gay men who had to wear the pink inverted triangle in Germany's concentration camps; the black triangle is in remembrance of lesbians who had to wear the inverted black triangle. The Atlanta PRIDE! shirt has the same front as the regular PRIDE! shirt AND has the PRIDE! flag and the Atlanta skyline in rainbow colors on the back. If you would like your town/city name below the PRIDE flag on the back of the shirt, let me know the name and I'll include your town/city name at no extra fee.

FashionArt Designs History: In 1992, on a beautiful, sunny, summer morning, I sat on my patio for my morning coffee. I looked at my coffee cup with a parrot on it. God, the unmistakable voice, spoke: "*Paint that parrot.*" I laughed at God and said out loud, "God, you know I'm the only person in history to make a C in high school art. Painting a parrot, no way." "*Paint the parrot!*" God demanded; I listened. While the parrot painting wasn't perfect, it was darn good. As I drew different designs that God inspired. God commanded: "Put these on a tee-shirt." I listened, bought the necessary supplies, and a few tee shirts. I shocked myself at the handiwork that I created with God. I didn't practice; I had no training, and I had absolutely no idea what I was doing. Like the Nike commercial, I just did it. I admitted to myself that this was a latent talent that arose. I wore my designer shirts.

Weeks later, as I moved forward in a line at an ATM machine and wearing my Atlanta skyline shirt, someone tugged at the back of my shirt and said, "wait, I'm finished reading your shirt." I had written different Atlanta events, landmarks, and parks in puffy paint filling the back of the shirt. "Where did you get that shirt? I want one." The nice, young man asked. "I made it," I answered, finally making it to the ATM machine. "How much is it?" he inquired. "50 dollars," I replied. "I'll take it," he politely demanded. "I'll make one for you," I said. "No, I want *that* shirt. We're about the same size, let's swap." We did, and he gave me \$50 cash! I still wear his shirt.

A few weeks later, the same thing happened in a bar with another man, except he didn't pay me. The kind guy served in the Army and the next day would be deployed to the middle east; I thought the least I could do to help serve the country was contribute a shirt to an Army private, so we swapped shirts.

The compliments began turning into cash or check with word of mouth, as my AT&T co-workers bought shirts for themselves and as gifts. I ran the business as a Schedule C business on my income tax. I had fun FashionArt Designs parties with my AT&T coworkers and friends, like the old Tupperware parties, except mine had alcohol, food, dancing, and lots of sales. Then, I visited women and gay/lesbian boutiques and specialty stores with success. I turned this hobby into a part-time job for six years. All before the Internet.

In 1998, I retired from AT&T and set out on a successful training/speaking, database consulting, and entertainment business, Techedutainment Services, Inc. I ceased the FashionArt business, but I did not cease designing, embellishing, and painting my own shirts.

Fast forward to the autumn of 2025, COVID-19 and artificial intelligence made training less personable and profitable. Beginning in 2020, I experienced tremendous loss of training/speaking business. At 68, I learned that most organizations do not hire people my age. They say: "You are overqualified." Being in HR, I know what that translates to: "You are too old and a liability; we don't hire people your age." And like many young people today, I need to find work that artificial intelligence cannot do; AI robots are not good at using puffy paint, YET. Again, God said: "Relaunch FashionArt." I said, "no, God, I don't want to be the CEO, CFO, CIO, Sales Vice-President, and Human Resources Director again; I want to work **FOR** someone; I don't want to be the boss." God responded, "I'm the Boss and that's not My plan, that's yours." So, FashionArt Designs reigns again.
